The Supremacy of His Power (vs. 15-17)

Colossians 1:15-17

He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. For by him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things were created by him and for him. He is before all things, and in him all things hold together.

The Supremacy of His Reconciliation (vs. 19-22)

Colossians 1:19-20a

For God was pleased to have all
his fullness dwell in him, and
through him to reconcile to himself
all things, whether things on earth
or things in heaven.

Colossians 1:20b

By making peace through his
blood, shed on the cross.

Colossians 1:21-22a

Once you were alienated from God and were enemies in your minds because of your evil behavior. But now he has reconciled you by Christ's physical body through death.

Colossians 1:22b

To present you holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation.

Colossians 1:23a

If you continue in your faith, established and firm, not moved from the hope held out in the gospel.

Matthew 7:21

Not everyone who says to me, "Lord, Lord," will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only he who does the will of my Father who is in heaven.

1 Peter 1:14-16

As obedient children, do not conform to the evil desires you had when you lived in ignorance. But just as he who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do; for it is written: "Be holy, because I am holy."
