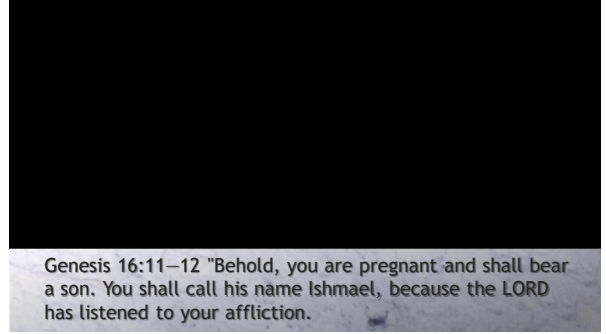
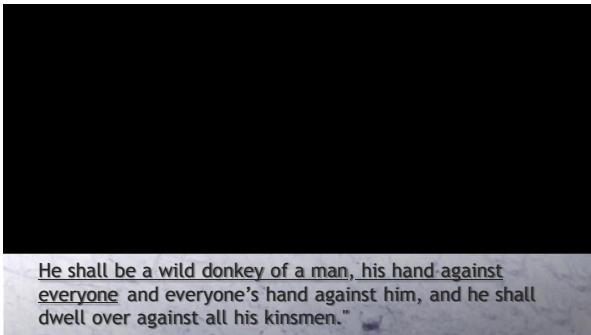


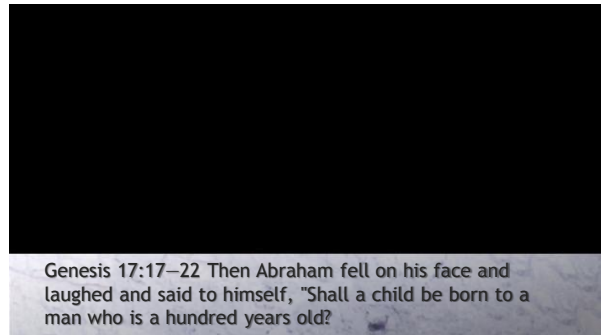
I. The birth of Islam



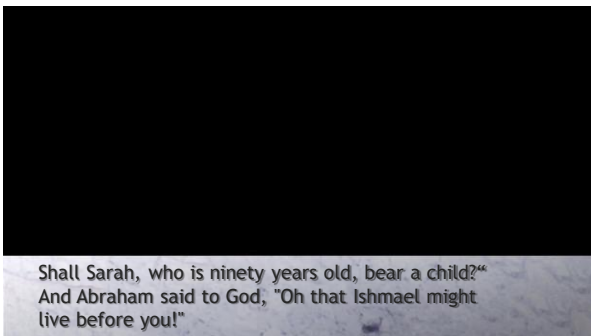
Genesis 16:11–12 "Behold, you are pregnant and shall bear a son. You shall call his name Ishmael, because the LORD has listened to your affliction.



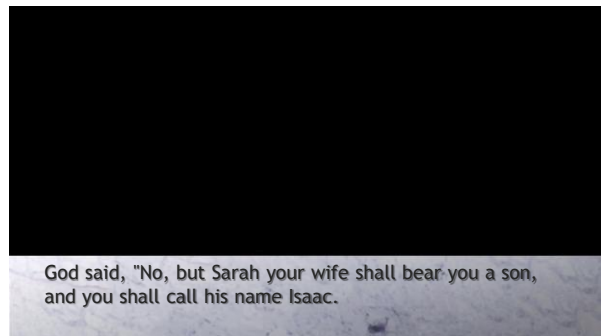
He shall be a wild donkey of a man, his hand against everyone and everyone's hand against him, and he shall dwell over against all his kinsmen."



Genesis 17:17–22 Then Abraham fell on his face and laughed and said to himself, "Shall a child be born to a man who is a hundred years old?"

III. The Birth of a New Christ in the Koran

Surah 3:42 "God has chosen you. He has made you pure and exalted you above womankind."

Surah 66:12 "And Mary, 'Imran's daughter, who preserved her chastity and into whose womb We breathed Our spirit;

who put her trust in the words of her Lord and His scriptures, and was truly devout."

Surah 19:29–30 "I am the servant of God. He has given me the Book and ordained me a prophet.

His blessing is on me wherever I go, and He has exhorted me to be steadfast in prayer and to give alms as long as I shall live."

Surah 19:35 God forbid that He Himself should beget a son!

I. The Death of Christ's Mission in the Koran

John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.

Surah 61:6 And remember, Jesus, the son of Mary, said: "O Children of Israel! I am the messenger of Allah (sent) to you, confirming the Law (which came) before me,

and giving Glad Tidings of a Messenger to come after me, whose name shall be Ahmad."

John 15:26 "But when the Helper comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth, who proceeds from the Father, he will bear witness...

John 14:16 And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever.

John 14:26 But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name,

he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you.

John 15:26 But when the Helper comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth, who proceeds from the Father, he will bear witness about me.

John 16:7–8 Nevertheless, I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you.

But if I go, I will send him to you. And when he comes, he will convict the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment.

II. The Death of Christ's Death in the Koran

Surah 4:157 "They denied the truth and uttered a monstrous falsehood against Mary. They declared: "We have put to death the Messiah, Jesus son of Mary,

the apostle of God.' They did not kill him, nor did they crucify him, but they thought they did."

Surah 19:30, 33 "I was blessed on the day I was born, and blessed I shall be on the day of my death; and may peace be unto me on the day when I shall be raised to life."

Josephus: Now there was about this time Jesus, a wise man, if it be lawful to call him a man; for he was a doer of wonderful works,

a teacher of such men as receive the truth with pleasure. He drew over to him both many of the Jews and many of the Gentiles. He was the Christ.

And when Pilate, at the suggestion of the principal men among us, had condemned him to the cross, those that loved him at the first did not forsake him;

for he appeared to them alive again the third day, as the divine prophets had foretold these and ten thousand other wonderful things concerning him.

And the tribe of Christians, so named for him, are not extinct at this day.

Surah 5:17 "They do blaspheme, who declare: 'God is the Messiah, the son of Mary.' Say:

'Who could prevent God, if He so willed, from destroying the Messiah, the son of Mary, his mother, and all the people of the earth?'"

Surah 5:116-117 "Then God will say: 'Jesus son of Mary, did you ever say to the people: "Worship me and my mother as gods besides God?"'

'Glory be to you,' he will answer, 'I could never have claimed what I have no right to. If I had ever said so, You would have surely known it.'

You know what is in my mind, but I know not what is in Yours. You alone know what is hidden.

I told them only what You bade me. I said: "Serve God, my Lord and your Lord."

Surah 4:159 "There is none among the People of the Book but will believe in him before his death; and on the Day of Resurrection he will bear witness against them."

Philippians 2:9–11 Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow,

in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
