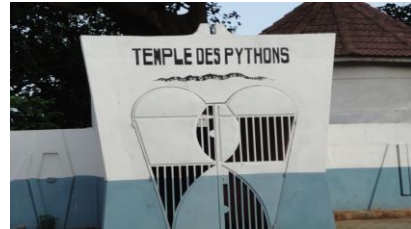

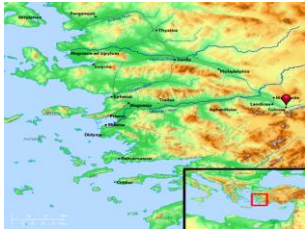

Now a buoyant growing church in Badagry

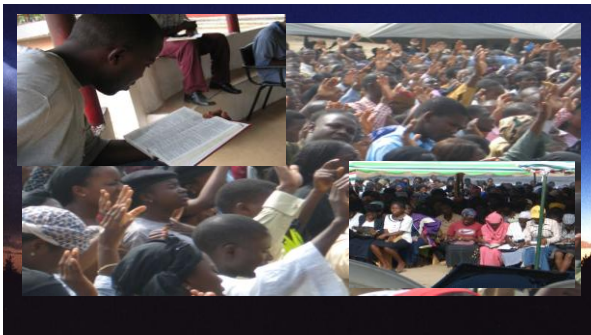

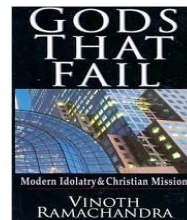

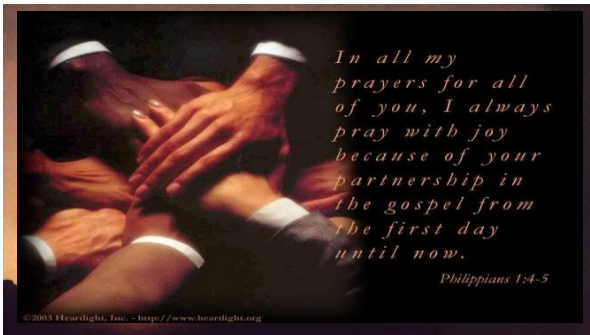
